**Goal 2: Restore 100 miles of Puget Sound shorelines**

The Alliance is working to restore shoreline habitat through on-the-ground actions taken with key partners, local communities and interested and engaged land owners. ***We seek to work with your organization to accomplish meaningful restoration actions along Puget Sound shorelines.***

**Key Restoration Actions**

1. **Increase restoration opportunities** – The Alliance seeks to accelerate the pace of Puget Sound shoreline restoration by identifying new restoration sites and needs and by enhancing and promoting existing efforts. In addition to working on our own projects, we are looking to tribes, government agencies, watershed and salmon recovery groups, Marine Resource Committees, and others for potential partnerships and good projects to advance. We will work to connect willing land owners with groups that have restoration expertise and identify the funding needed to complete both large and small projects.

2. **Outcomes** – Achieve the following key restoration outcomes through Alliance activities:

- Nourish beaches and remove shoreline armoring
- Re-vegetate Banks and bluffs
- Restore and enhance tidal marshes
- Survey and remove invasive species
- Restore native shellfish beds
- Remove marine debris such as creosote wood and derelict gear

3. **Key partners and efforts** – Work with many groups to achieve restoration outcomes:

- Governor's Puget Sound Partnership
- Shared Strategy, SRF Board and Lead Entities
- Puget Sound Action Team
- Puget Sound Nearshore Partnership/Puget Sound Ecosystem Restoration Project
- Northwest Straits Commission and marine Resource Committees
- Tribes
- WDFW, DNR Aquatic Lands Division and other state agencies
- Federal Agencies like NOAA, USFWS, US Army Corps and EPA that fund projects
- Local governments and incorporated authorities
- Land trusts, NGOs and interested members of the public
